<p>Questions to ask the interviewer:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ What is the company culture like? ▪ What is the team like? ▪ How many people are there in the team? ▪ How many people are there in the company? ▪ What would a typical day involve? ▪ How much responsibility will I have? ▪ Is it a sociable office? ▪ Is this a new or existing role? ▪ What are the working hours of the company? ▪ What else can you tell me about the company? ▪ Do you have offices abroad? ▪ Where do you manufacture?
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<p>Questions NOT to ask the interviewer:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How much will I get paid? (You should have found this out before the interview) ▪ Can I take two weeks' holiday in the first month? ▪ How much holiday can I take? ▪ Will I be promoted? ▪ Can I move to a different department after 3 months? ▪ Will I have to make the tea? ▪ Will I have to do the filing and photocopying? ▪ Can I leave early on Fridays? ▪ Can I have Mondays off? ▪ Can I leave after one month if I don't like it?
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
